Interface Stats and Alerts

Interface Statistics

- Link State
 - Link can be up (running) or down (not running)
 - Can have alerts for when a link goes down
- Speed/Duplex
 - Speed is how quickly data is being transferred
 - Half-Duplex means devices can only send or receive data (not both)
 - Full-Duplex is when devices can send and receive data



Interface Statistics

- Cyclic Redundancy Checks (CRCs)
 - Error-detecting code
 - Commonly used in digital networks and storage devices to detect accidental changes to raw data
- Protocol Packet
 - What protocol is the packet using?
- Byte Counts
 - How large is the packet?



Interface Errors or Alerts

- CRC Errors
 - When packets have been damaged
- Giants
 - Packets that are discarded because they exceed the maximum packet size allowed
- Runts
 - Packets that are discarded because they do not meet the minimum packet size allowed
- Encapsulation Errors
 - Missing some elements from the headers
